 - ii. F/YR20/0356/F Change of use from B & B/part residential to 4 bed dwelling at 17 Brickmakers Arms Lane Doddington
 - b) Other Planning Matters
 - i) F/YR20/0339/CERTLU Certificate of lawfulness (existing) siting of a mobile home at Caravan land north of The Warren Parsons Land Drove Doddington.
This is not a planning application but a request from FDC for local knowledge to establish the history of the site.
 - ii) F/YR20/0265/RM This application was supported by the Parish Council at last month's Council meeting but we have now been informed that the application has been withdrawn
